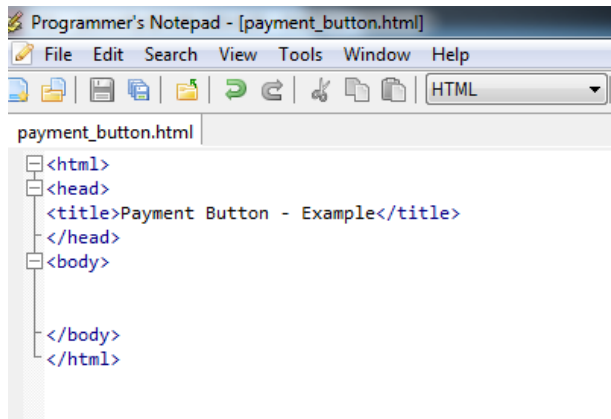

Recurring Payment Button – Setup Instructions

1. Firstly create a new website page e.g. payment_button.html and open the new page in a text editor



2. Copy all of the text in the blue section below;

4. Replace the following fields with the relevant information

- a. [Your Registered Nochex Email Address] – Your registered Nochex recurring email address, for example: example@mybusiness.com
- b. [Amount] – Amount you wish to be paid, for example: 1.00
- c. [Description] – Description of the recurring payment e.g. Subscription to “Nochex Monthly” magazine
- d. [Interval_number] – Number of time periods between each recurrence e.g. 2
- e. [Interval_unit] – The interval for each recurrence e.g. M or Y
- f. [Recurrence_Number] – Number of times the payment will recur, e.g. 2 (Note: if the recurring payment is on-going and doesn’t have a recurrence number use a value of N.)
- g. [Recurring_Payment] – Must contain the value 1 to enable recurring payments

5. Save all changes, and open your website page in a web browser to test everything has been setup correctly.

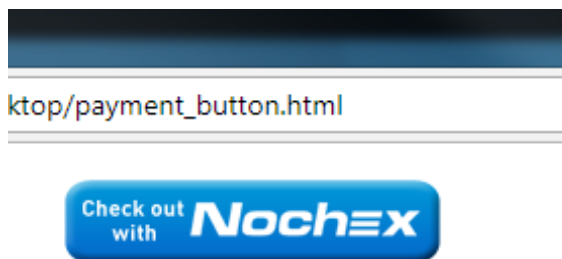
1. Open your website page that contains the NOCHEX Form / Payment button in a text editor.
