Setting Up Nochex as a Payment Option

- With the Nochex payments module installed you can not only accept credit card payments but also Nochex members can pay using their Nochex account.
- Customers don't even need a Nochex account to make payments through Nochex making it quick and easy for customers to make payments.
- Nochex uses anti-fraud protection like 3D Secure – the leading “Internet Authentication Protocol” designed by Visa and MasterCard, to ensure your customers can make payments in confidence.
- Emails are sent directly from Nochex giving payment confirmation both to the customer and the seller.

The installation instructions below explain how to setup Nochex as a payment option in StoreSprite.

Installation Instructions

1. Firstly **login** to your StoreSprite account.
2. Go to **Settings** and select **Payment Methods**.

3. Select **Configure** on the NoChex payment method option.

4. At the **Configure NoChex** page input all the relevant details. It is recommended that you enable test mode and complete a test transaction to check that everything is working. Always remember to disable test mode when you want to go live otherwise you won't be able to accept any payments.
