## Nochex Payment Module for MP Restaurant

A guide to the installation of the Nochex payment module for MP Restaurant. All the information you need to start accepting Nochex payments in MP Restaurant.

Before using this guide you will need to have a Nochex account, if you haven't already signed up click the following link and choose between either a Seller or a Merchant account:

## Setting Up Nochex as a Payment Option

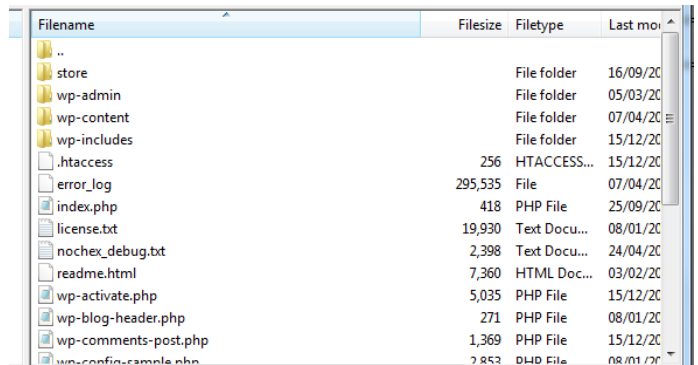
- With the Nochex payments module installed you can not only accept credit card payments but also Nochex members can pay using their Nochex account.
- Customers don't even need a Nochex account to make payments through Nochex making it quick and easy for customers to make payments.
- Nochex uses anti-fraud protection like 3D Secure – the leading “Internet Authentication Protocol” designed by Visa and MasterCard, to ensure your customers can make payments in confidence.
- Emails are sent directly from Nochex giving payment confirmation both to the customer and the seller.

The installation instructions below explain how to setup Nochex as a payment option in MP Restaurant.

# Installation Instructions

1. Firstly you must have WordPress and the MP Restaurant plugin installed on your website.

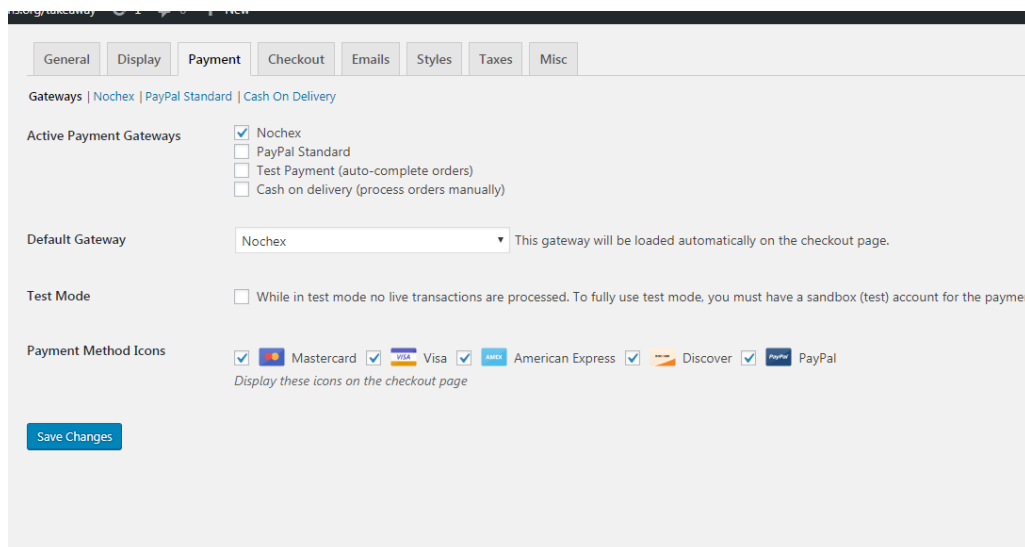
2. Make sure you have downloaded the Nochex module for MP Restaurant ZIP file located [here](#)



3. Once downloaded, extract and open the folder.


4. Copy the files from the folder to the corresponding folders on your web server. You can use FTP for this process or a file manager.

5. Once the files have been copied, Login to your WordPress Admin Section, and go to your Payment Gateway settings in your MP Restaurant Plugin, which can be found: Restaurant Menu > Settings > Payments.



6. Enable Nochex as an Active Payment Gateway, and choose Nochex as your Preferred Default Gateway.

7. Press Nochex to show specific settings / fields for Nochex.



8. Enter your Nochex Merchant Email Address / Alias ID, and test transaction mode to Yes

**(NB: Remember to change Test Mode from Test to Live when you want to start accepting live transactions)**

9. Save all changes.
